

Alliance Medical Ministry is seeking a **full time or part time physician** who will provide direct patient care and be a part of a strong leadership team making a difference for a diverse and underserved patient population. AMM offers a very competitive compensation package AND rewarding work and life- work balance.

Alliance Medical Ministry is a non profit based in Raleigh , N.C. that provides access to comprehensive medical care to working, uninsured Wake County residents. Uninsured individuals are less likely to receive preventive care, more likely to develop chronic illnesses, and more likely to be hospitalized for conditions that could have been prevented. Most uninsured families struggle financially to meet basic needs, and medical bills, even for minor problems, can quickly lead to medical debt.

AMM provides a primary care medical home to nearly 2,200 low-income adults. Patient demographics are: 69% of patients are women, 79% have one or more chronic illnesses, 53% are Spanish-speaking, and 89% are non-Caucasian. The average patient supports a household of three on \$19,900 annually, and lives in southeast Raleigh. Comprehensive medical care provided at AMM includes acute and chronic medical care, lab and pharmacy services, health education and wellness programs, disease management, counseling, an on-site community garden, and a comprehensive wellness program. Patients are referred to Alliance from local area hospital emergency departments, other local social service organizations, and by word of mouth.

Comprehensive care at AMM focuses on the body, mind, spirit and the social context of our patients and incorporates care and services to help our patients improve lifestyle and health outcomes. AMM provides access to fresh food through our community garden, health education and disease management classes, yoga and other exercise programs, and cooking and gardening classes. AMM patients also have access to mental health services through our pastoral care and counseling program.

We know that providing medical care and medication is not enough. Key to supporting our patients is to help identify and address barriers to health. A deep connection exists between physical health and mental health, and between social issues and health outcomes. We treat AMM patients with that in mind.

Physician Duties:

- Serve as primary care provider for a panel of patients
- Function effectively in care team with Medical Assistant to provide compassionate continuity of care for patients.
- Obtain health history and perform physical exams.
- Arrange for standard of care preventive measures, including cancer screenings and immunizations as needed.
- Diagnose and develop treatment plans with the patients.
- Prescribe medications as allowed by federal, state and professional guidelines utilizing low-cost programs including Pharmacy Assistance Program, NC MedAssist, and FIGS.
- Arrange referral for necessary labs, imaging and specialty consults utilizing Charity Care programs and Project Access (a Wake County Medical Society program).

- Maintain current and unrestricted North Carolina medical license.
- Board Certification in Internal Medicine or Family Medicine.
- Skill in management of complex patients and preventive health .
- Skill in collaboration with medical staff and team members.
- Proficiency in EPIC
- Spanish language fluency a plus.
