

## PLANNED GIVING COMMITMENT FORM

The Planned Giving Program manages the transfer of assets to NCAFCC during a donor's lifetime <u>or</u> as part of an estate plan. This approach to giving is "planned" because often these assets are not liquid, have tax consequences and are generally transferred via a will or other written method, including this form and any accompanying documentation. NCAFCC's Planned Giving Program includes:

- Bequests (naming NCAFCC as a beneficiary in a will or living trust);
- Charitable Remainder Trust (a gift of cash in return for variable payments (% of gift). Upon passing, remainder is distributed to NCAFCC);
- Charitable Gift Annuity (a gift of cash or stock in return for fixed payments to the donor for life. Upon passing, remainder is distributed to NCAFCC);
- Retained Life Estate (a gift of a primary residence, vacation home or other property).
